#WeAreBFC

- Established in 2013, the Blues are owned by the JSW Group, and have been the most successful club over the last decade in Indian Football.
- Bengaluru FC reached the final of the AFC Cup 2016 and became the first club from India to reach the final of a continental club tournament in the history of Indian Football.
- BFC youth academy was awarded AFC 2 star accreditation in July 2020, thereby became the only youth academy of a professional club to have be awarded this status in the country.

- With structured emphasis given to Grassroots, Community Programs, Corporate Social Responsibility and Fan engagement, the club has become the benchmark in Indian football.
- A club of and for the fans, Bengaluru FC has managed to capture the affection of thousands of supporters in Karnataka and across the country, in just seven years of existence.
- More than 30 players from the Bengaluru FC roster have gone on to represent the Indian National Football Team in various age groups over the last seven seasons.









WE BELIEVE IN YOUTH

BFC is committed to nurturing talent and investing in a full fledge football development program including a fully paid Youth Academy Set Up

Seventeen BFC players have earned their first cap for Senior Indian National Team during their time at the club.

Udanta Singh made his debut for the club in 2014, and has positioned himself as a important player in the starting XI after helping the team win six trophies

Suresh Singh Wangjam has risen through the ranks to become an integral member of the Bengaluru FC squad

Naorem Roshan Singh, scouted for the reserves team in 2018-19 season, broke into the first team, picked up multiple honours along with a call up to the Indian National Team. He was named the Emerging Player of the 2021-22 Indian Super League season.

Young Sivasakthi Narayan, scouted into the club's youth development program in 2020, is the latest in a line of talent to break into the first team, having finished as the club's top-scorer at the Durand Cup, along with scoring the opener in the final against Mumbai City FC.

BFC is the first and only football club In India to have its Youth Academy conferred the two-star status by The Asian Football Confederation (AFC) under The AFC Elite Youth Scheme.



In 2019 it was announced that The Blues from India and The Gers entered a strategic partnership to improve visiblity and share ideas to advance the game in either country. Improving the youth system in India was one of the focal points of this agreement. Periodically, Rangers have also sent Academy Team scouts to the BFC Academy to keep an eye out for potential talent.

- The residential camps also allows students to showcase their skills and talent which can act as scouting ground for Elite & Academy Teams.










HIGH PERFORMANCE CAMP
